

Teen- and Male-Friendly Clinic Check List

This checklist is a tool to help you determine whether or not you are using some basic ways to make your clinic site(s) teen and male friendly. 1.	We have teen friendly materials in our waiting room(s) and patient exam rooms. Materials could include magazines, brochures, videos, or posters that appeal to teen issues.		
2.	We have male friendly materials in our waiting room(s) and patient exam rooms.		
3.	We have a private/confidential area where adolescents or males can discuss the reason for their visit with clinic staff.		
4.	Staff has been trained on health and social issues that are relevant to teens such as HPV, HIV, STIs, teen birth rates, teen suicide, intimate partner violence, date rape, etc.		
5.	Staff has been trained on health and social issues relevant to males such as STIs, testicular cancer, intimate partner violence, the male role in family planning, etc.		
6.	We have appropriate resources readily available to provide to teens when needed (domestic violence services, mental health services, suicide hot-line, etc.)		
7.	We have resources readily available to provide to males when needed (substance abuse treatment services, mental health services, etc.)		
8.	We have specific teen clinic hours that are convenient for teens.		
9.	We have health educators or peer educators that are specifically designed to deal with our teen clients.		
10.	All staff has been trained on California's Mandatory Reporting laws.		
11.	All staff has been trained on Emergency Contraception (EC).		
12.	We use incentives to encourage teen and male clinic visits and follow-up visits.		
13.	We use a medical history form that includes issues that are specific to teens. (E.g. Do you have an adult in your life that you can trust or talk to?)		
14.	We use a medical history form that includes issues that are specific to males.
