

Comprehensive Family Planning

Family PACT (Planning, Access, Care and Treatment) is a publicly-funded family planning program designed to provide “comprehensive family planning services” to low-income men and women in California with no other source of family planning and reproductive health care insurance coverage.

Access to Family PACT services fills a gap in health care for uninsured and underinsured clients of child bearing age

Family PACT reimburses providers for these client services:

- Contraceptive methods
- Emergency contraception
- STI testing and treatment
- Pregnancy testing and counseling
- Sterilization
- HIV testing
- Limited female and male cancer screening
- Education and counseling

Education and Counseling

Health educators or clinical staff with appropriate skills can provide reimbursable family planning and reproductive health education and counseling

To become an enrolled Family PACT provider, you must

- Be a current Medi-Cal provider in good standing
- Attend a Family PACT Orientation & Update Session
- Submit completed Application and Enrollment Agreement forms
