## Provider Orientation & Update Session March 29, 2012

In order to become a Family PACT provider, individual and group providers wishing to enroll must send a physician-owner to this session. Licensed community clinics (e.g., FQHCs, RHCs, IHCs and government providers) wishing to enroll must send the medical director, physician or nurse practitioner responsible for oversight of family planning services rendered at the site. **Participants MUST be on time and attend the entire Orientation training. Failure to attend the entire session may result in the inability to receive a Certificate of Attendance.** Additional staff and current Family PACT providers/staff are welcome to register. Registration begins at 8:00 a.m. with Session I beginning promptly at 8:30 a.m.

**Session 1 Overview of the Family PACT Program:** 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Attendance at this presentation is mandatory for the medical director, physician or nurse practitioner and is recommended for other staff members who are new to the program or in need of a refresher.

**Session 2 Clinical Practice Alerts:** 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. The medical director, physician or nurse practitioner in attendance must also attend this session. Free continuing education credit is available for Session II (please bring your medical license number with you if requesting CE credit; a continuing education request form will be available during onsite registration). Other interested clinical staff members are welcome to attend this session.

**Session 3 Tips for Successful Family PACT Administration:** 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Administrators and billers interested in Family PACT program administration and billing information may attend. When registering, please identify the session(s) you plan to attend.
