Special Interest Trainings are offered to Family PACT providers and staff to increase awareness or provide new and updated information on specific topics identified by the California Department of Public Health, Office of Family Planning.

### Intrauterine Contraception Insertion Training

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Many studies have shown intrauterine contraception to be a highly effective method of contraception, yet it continues to be underutilized in the U.S. This session will ensure that clinicians are adequately trained to offer this method to their clients and that they understand the expanded eligibility criteria for this method. This clinical practicum includes background information and insertion techniques for both the Mirena and ParaGard intrauterine contraceptives. Hands on practice will be supervised by experienced preceptors. Space is limited to the first 50 participants in each location.
