This session provides an overview of proper coding procedures clinicians should consider when assigning E/M codes for Family PACT visits. Selecting the appropriate level of E/M code supported by chart documentation will be discussed. The Family PACT Provider Profile indicators relating to the use of E/M codes within a practice also will be addressed.

1. Describe the use of the three key components when assigning an E/M code.
2. Explain the difference between using "face-to-face time" and the 3 key components when assigning an E/M code.
3. Describe the use of E/M codes when a procedure occurs at the same visit.
