Four Ways to Participate:

Course Description

This webcast will present findings on sexually transmitted infection (STI) and HIV testing trends based on analyses of Family PACT claims data for Fiscal Year 09/10. Focus will be placed on how these data may reflect adherence to national and program standards for quality STI care and how to prioritize quality interventions.

Objectives

At the conclusion, participants will be able to:

1. Describe the utilization patterns of STI/HIV testing services by type, gender, age and race.
2. Describe differences in chlamydia and gonorrhea prevalence by age among female clients.
3. Identify potential priority areas for quality intervention, e.g. increase chlamydia screening of young female clients, targeted testing of older female clients, targeted gonorrhea screening, and retesting of chlamydia cases
