Postpartum Contraception

Course Description

During the very busy and exhausting time in a woman's life, convenience and effectiveness are very important to her selecting a contraceptive. Impacts of contraception on breastfeeding and an infant's wellbeing must be considered. Recently, estimates of increased VTE risk and newer estimates of uterine perforation raise new questions about safety of postpartum use of some of the new methods. New techniques have been tested to make safe and reliable methods available to women immediately following delivery, but current reimbursement coverage may make these options, financially impossible. These issues will all be reviewed in this upcoming webcast.

Objectives

At the end of this presentation, the participants will be able to:

1. Describe the need for contraception in the postpartum period.
2. Outline the procedures for immediate postpartum IUD placement and estimate the rates of complications.
3. Estimate the risk of VTE in immediate postpartum period and impact estrogen containing methods might have on those risks.
4. Counsel women on the risks that use of progestin-only methods might have on breastfeeding success and on glucose tolerance for women with GDM.
